Notes for Teachers:

If you are the lead invigilator, please ensure the exam papers are ready at the exam hall, before the start of the exam.

Lead invigilators are highlighted in bold.

Lead invigilators must make sure to take both exam boxes, papers & dispatch logs (which will be made ready for them prior to exam).

Lead invigilators must sign & fill in the exam registers, prepare the exam papers in order in the postal bag, with the labels on, ready for dispatch.

Notes for Students:

All candidates must bring their candidate statement of entry to the exam.

All candidates must arrive on time and with all necessary stationery and correct uniform.

Candidates arriving late will NOT be allowed to sit the exam.

All candidates must sit according to seating plan.

All candidates must adhere to the rules and regulations of examinations as set out by the JCQ (posters will be in exam hall).

All examinations are by default to be held in the 2nd floor new hall (2FH) except Arabic speaking, which will be held in the meeting room (MTR).

There could be changes to exam locations due to extreme circumstances, in that instance, all students will be notified by a suitable method.

For morning (AM) examinations candidates must attend at 8:45am.

For afternoon (PM) examinations candidates must attend at 1:30 pm. All candidates must perform Duhur Salah with Jamah at 1:30 pm after which the PM examinations will take place.
